**Explanation of Costs:**

**Headquarters Fee:** This fee is our Headquarters Administration Fee and enrollments each Member into our youth program's Excess Health Insurance Policy. This insurance is only open to U.S. Naval Sea Cadet Corps Members. This Policy is only valid during scheduled, sponsored, and approved U.S. Naval Sea Cadet Corps events and while traveling uninterrupted to and from such events. This insurance is considered secondary, except when an individual has no health insurance, this insurance becomes their primary insurance. Pre-existing conditions are not covered under this policy. The Headquarters Fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

**Uniforms:** This is a one-time fee to purchase uniforms for New Cadets. Uniforms are exchangeable at any time for larger or smaller sizes if needed. Falcon Division purchases U.S. Navy Uniforms through the U.S. Naval Sea Cadet Corps Uniform Depot at Recruit Training Command, Great Lakes. Buying these Uniforms on your own would cost thousands, while we can order them at a discount. This fee does not include other personal items needed to complete a "sea bag" (socks, t-shirts, underwear, etc.).

**Falcon Division Unit Funds:** This fee is used to purchase our unit's paper, ink, and Cadet awards.

**Summer/Winter Nationwide Trainings:** This cost is for our national trainings outside the unit. Cadets are required to attend **at least** one training per calendar year. All Cadets 14 and older are **required** to go to Recruit Training in their first year. Current costs for national trainings are \$175 for a 1-week training, \$250 for a 10-day training, and \$350 for a 14-day training. Recruit Training is 8-days and costs \$225. Training length varies depends on the training selected. Training cost includes instruction and room and board. Transport to and from the training location is not included.

**Three for Free Program:** If Cadets help enroll three (3) Cadets into Falcon Division, our HQ will pay the training fee for whichever training they choose. There is no limit on how many free trainings can be earned this way (i.e. Enroll 6 Cadets, get two (2) free trainings, and so on).
