UNIT NOTES

- **BRING YOUR CORRESPONDENCE COURSE ANSWERS** – you cannot be promoted if you don't pass courses.
- **WINTER TRAININGS:** Cadets who attended winter training – RETURN YOUR SERVICE JACKETS.
- **INDOC CADETS UNIFORM THIS DRILL:** For all new recruits/INDOC cadets who are not uniformed yet will now report in a navy blue shirt and pants (i.e. "nice" jeans, khakis, dress slacks, etc).
- **REPORT CARDS:** Every cadet from here on out is REQUIRED by Falcon Division SOPs to provide a report card bi-annually in January and August. Bring a copy of your report card/homeschool report with you and turn them in during morning muster.
- **ADVANCEMENT EXAMS:** As per LT Covey's email last week, if you are eligible to test for advancement and would like to test, come prepared and notify your Chain of Command during Morning Muster for scheduling during drill.
- **USNSCC PT UNIFORM:** As per NHQ directive as of December 2018, the official USNSCC PT Uniform is required for all advanced trainings. Therefore, Falcon Division will now require this of a cadet's official Sea Bag. PT Uniforms are purchased through Vanguard at the cadet/guardian's expense. Unfortunately, this is not a uniform item the unit can obtain and stock like the NWUs, etc. Any time we are scheduled to have PT at drill from now on, cadets shall wear the official PT uniform. If you do not have it yet, you may wear a navy blue shirt and blue or black shorts/pants.
- **RIBBONS/AWARDS:** It is LT Covey's sincere desire to award as many ribbons as possible to as many cadets as possible; it is a physical recognition of your efforts inside and outside the Sea Cadet organization and serves as a permanent record to use for college or job applications. However, it is YOUR responsibility (the cadet) to provide the unit staff with the required documentation to facilitate these awards. As with all other policy, the list of awards and requirements are listed in the Awards Manual in the Policy section of homeport.seacadets.org.
- **ATTENDANCE:** We are going to try a new attendance reporting procedure this month and see how it goes. It is important to inform your chain of command of all absences, excused and non-excused, prior to drill dates. Cadets (not parents) are required to mark their intended attendance via the Google Sheet at the following address: <https://docs.google.com/spreadsheets/d/1FVjeDJ-fNxOGYYAXXMhngerABQHax61iQdSrh4wwwgw/edit?usp=sharing>. This is due NLT (no later than) 1800 Friday before a normally scheduled Saturday drill date. Refer to the previously released SOPs for further attendance questions or contact your Chain of Command.
